### Tie breakers:

1. Full Buchholz
2. Cut buchholz (without opponent with the least amount of points)
3. Result of the mutual game
4. Number of wins
5. Armagedon (in case it affects prizes)

Decisions of the chief arbiter during the tournament are definitive

The organizer will provide chess sets and chess clocks for all participants.
